Welcome - Recognizing Crisis and Opportunity in Leadership

In this session, we will explore the current landscape of leadership within the church and society. Understanding both the crises we face and the opportunities they present is key to stepping into effective Kingdom leadership.

A. We Live in a Moment of Great Crisis and Great Opportunity

- The church has lost significant influence in many areas, including culture, media, education, and government.
- Despite this decline, God desires to revive the church and restore its influence in the world.
- Every crisis presents an opportunity for growth and leadership development.

B. Our Loss of Influence Indicates a Crisis of Leadership Among God's People

- Over the past 50 years, the withdrawal of the church from key societal spheres has created a leadership vacuum.
- This vacuum has been filled by individuals and groups who do not operate from a biblical worldview.
- To reclaim influence, we must raise our “leader-level” and embrace our God-given roles as leaders.

C. It's Time for the People of God to Rise Up and Pursue a Leadership Upgrade

- Many world-changing leaders began their journeys decades ago, often sparked by movements like the Jesus Movement in the late '60s and early '70s.
- While some embraced an escapist mindset, withdrawing from societal engagement, others pursued long-term leadership strategies that shaped culture.
- We are called to adopt a “longview” approach to leadership, restoring influence across all areas of society.

D. The Church is the Answer

- The church is God’s plan A for transforming the world, and there is no plan B.
- Reaching people, making disciples, and developing leaders must happen through the local church.
- Healthy churches depend on healthy leaders. Leaders Alliance exists to raise the leader-level in every sphere—churches, businesses, families, non-profits, and more.
