In this session, we will explore the essence of Kingdom leadership through the lens of disciple-making. Understanding your role as both a king and a priest in God's Kingdom will equip and empower you to lead with purpose and spiritual authority.

A. We Are Called to Make Disciples Who Make Disciples (Matthew 28:18-20)

- The Great Commission calls us to make disciples of all nations.
- Disciple-making requires growing in leadership ability.
- This calling is not limited to church settings but extends to homes, organizations, and communities.
- Our mission is to equip and empower every disciple to be a world changer.

B. Our Definition of Equip: Provide Practical Principles of Biblical Leadership

- Jesus redeemed us to be **kings and priests** (Revelation 1:5-6; 5:8-10).
- Equipping leaders involves a combination of the **supernatural** and the **super-practical**:
 - **Supernatural**: Embracing spiritual gifts, hearing God's voice, and operating in divine authority.
 - **Super-practical**: Applying biblical leadership principles in real-life situations.
- We provide practical resources and tools rooted in Scripture to support leadership growth.

C. Our Definition of Empower: Help People Understand How to Access the Presence and Power of God

- Psalm 127:1 reminds us, "Unless the Lord builds the house, those who build it labor in vain."
- Thriving as a leader requires being filled and continually refilled with the **Holy Spirit**.
- Empowerment comes from:
 - Intimacy with God.
 - Recognizing and activating spiritual gifts.
 - Receiving guidance from the Holy Spirit in everyday leadership decisions.
