Welcome - Knowing Your Identity in Christ

Your identity in Christ is the foundation of your leadership. Understanding who you are in Him will shape how you lead and influence others.

Key Scriptures:

- Christ in you is the hope of glory (Colossians 1:27).
- You are forgiven, born again, and indwelt with the Holy Spirit (John 3, Romans 8:15).
- You are chosen to partner with Jesus in His mission (John 15:6).
- He loves you deeply (Jeremiah 31:3, Romans 5:8, 1 John 3:1-3).

A. Leadership Starts with Identity

Leadership flows from identity. Who you are in Christ determines how you lead. The moment you got saved, you came under the Lordship of Jesus, the ultimate leader. While past experiences and skills matter, your relationship with Jesus brings a new, powerful dimension to your leadership.

B. The Mission of Jesus: To Restore Humanity to Our True Destiny

Jesus came to restore people to their God-given purpose (Genesis 1). He gave His life to birth a “new creation” people who would fulfill His mission. As His body, sons and daughters, and Spirit-filled believers, we walk in this restored destiny.

C. Identity Theft: The Enemy’s Strategy

The enemy seeks to **kill, steal, and destroy** confidence in Jesus (John 10:10). If he can keep us unaware of our true identity, he can weaken our leadership. When Jesus was tempted in the wilderness, the first attack was against His identity as the Son of God. But Jesus knew **who He was and whose He was**, and He responded with the Word of God.

If we stand firm in our identity, the enemy’s attacks lose power.

D. You in Christ: Discovering the Full Meaning of Identity

Your leadership effectiveness depends on knowing who you are in Christ. The more you understand your identity, the more confidently you will walk in your calling.
