Welcome - First Step in Destiny Discovery: Reviewing Your History

God has been actively involved in shaping your identity since before you were born. Understanding your past—both the blessings and challenges—helps you discover the destiny God has prepared for you.

Key Scriptures:

- You are able to love God because He first loved you (1 John 4:19).
- God had a plan for your life before you were conceived (Psalm 139).
- Even with negative experiences, God works all things for good (Romans 8:28).

A. God Knew You Before You Knew Him - From Your Mother's Womb

- You were known and loved by God before birth (Psalm 139).
- He created you with a purpose, forming your identity before you understood it.
- Your calling is part of His divine plan, and your history is a key to understanding it.

B. Formative Experiences: God Has Been at Work in Your Life

- Your past—both good and bad—has shaped your identity and leadership potential.
- God redeems past wounds, using them to prepare you for your calling.
- Meditating on God's truth will transform your thinking (Psalm 1).

C. God Drew You to Jesus - Your Salvation Story

- You have been transferred from darkness into His Kingdom (Colossians 1:13-14).
- The lies of the past are dismantled when you believe the truth (John 8:31-32).
- Your testimony of salvation is a powerful reminder of God's work in your life.

D. Healthy Leadership Requires a Healthy Heart

- Leadership flows from an **intimate relationship with God**.
- Lies and wounds from childhood can shape our perceptions, but the Holy Spirit brings healing.
- Successful leadership starts with knowing **who you are in Christ** and walking in truth.
