Welcome - Developing the Right Mindset

To walk in our God-given identity, we must develop the **right mindset**—one that is shaped by truth and renewed by the Word of God.

A. Identity Depends on the Right Mindset - Transformed by the Renewing of Your Mind

- Scripture teaches that we are transformed by **renewing our minds** (Romans 12:1-2).
- Developing a Kingdom mindset requires **letting go of limiting beliefs** and aligning our thinking with God's truth.
- We have the **mind of Christ** (1 Corinthians 2:16), enabling us to think as He does.

B. Embedded Lies Will Keep You From God and Your Destiny

- Many of us have **absorbed lies from childhood** that distort our identity.
- The enemy, described as the **father of lies** (John 8:44), seeks to keep us from walking in freedom.
- If we believe lies, they become **strongholds** that hinder our growth.
- Walking in truth **requires replacing those lies with God's promises**.

C. Identifying Lies and Replacing Them With Truth

- Jesus said, **“You will know the truth, and the truth will set you free”** (John 8:32).
- Our **feelings reflect what we believe to be true**, not necessarily what is true.
- As we change our beliefs to align with truth, our **emotions and actions follow**.

D. Renewing Your Mind is a Lifelong Process

- Transformation comes through **consistent exposure to Scripture and time with God**.
- A great practice is to **read the Bible regularly** and learn to recognize the voice of the Holy Spirit.
- We are called to be **humble, surrendered, and alive to God's will**.
