Welcome - Discover Your Destiny

Your identity in Christ defines your purpose. Understanding **who you are**, **where you are going**, and **how you will get there** will shape your leadership journey.

A. Who Are You? Discover Your True Identity

- As a believer, you are a **child of God**, adopted into His family, fully loved by the Father, and co-heir with Christ.
- Your identity is **fundamentally different** from that of a non-Christian—you are **in Christ**, which grants you new benefits, abilities, and purpose.
- Scripture tells us that we belong to God, and we are **both His servants and His children** (Ephesians 1:5, Romans 8:16-17).

B. Where Are You Going? Discover Your True Destiny

- Destiny refers to your **calling, ministry, dreams, and life purpose**.
- Ephesians 2:10 – "We are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them."
- Your destiny is **specific to you**—it is not just general good deeds but the **unique mission God has given you**.
- Just like the parable of the talents (Matthew 25:14-30), God has given each person different gifts and expects us to steward them well.
- Destiny is a **partnership between you and God**—you choose to **cooperate with His plan** (Philippians 2:12-13).

C. How Will You Get There?

- Your personal development and growth require **intentional planning and discipline**.
- Key habits that build strong leadership:
 - **Daily prayer and Bible reading** – Prioritizing time with God strengthens your vision.
 - **Self-discipline** – Structure your life in a way that aligns with your calling.
 - **Goal setting** – Define practical steps that move you toward fulfilling your mission.
- Practical tip: Consider using a **One-Year Bible plan** to build a habit of daily Scripture reading.

Reflection Questions:

1. **Do you know who you are in Christ? How would you describe your true identity?**

2. **Where do you believe God is leading you? What is your calling or destiny?**

3. **How do you see yourself fulfilling your destiny? What steps can you take?**



Activation:

Step 1: Who Are You?

Describe your primary gifts, passions, and personality traits. What makes you unique?

Step 2: Where Are You Going?

Write down your Kingdom calling—what do you believe God has called you to do?

Step 3: How Will You Get There?

Describe how you will accomplish this vision. What are your main objectives and strategies?

These are the three core destiny questions: Who are you? Where are you going? How will you get there? Answering them will help you align your life with God's plan for you.
