### Welcome - Ministry Development Goals

Ministry development is a practical process that requires planning, strategy, and partnership with the Holy Spirit. A dream without a plan remains just a dream. To effectively step into your calling, you must clarify your destination and set actionable goals.

#### A. Approximate Your Destination

- Clarifying your **calling, ministry, life purpose, or dream** is the first step.
- Be **specific** about where you are headed, even if you refine it later.
- As the saying goes, if you aim at nothing, you're sure to hit it.

#### B. The Journey Guide PRO: Mapping Your Development Process

- Utilize tools like the **Journey Guide PRO** to refine your vision and mission.
- Research **training, legal requirements, finances, and team-building needs**.
- Set goals that are measurable and adaptable as you grow in your calling.

#### C. Partnering with the Holy Spirit in Goal Setting

- Some believe planning isn't "spiritual," but **Jesus emphasized the need for preparation** (Luke 14:28-32).
- Example: A builder calculates costs before starting a project, and a king prepares before going to battle.
- **God has a master plan for your life**—seek Him for direction while setting practical goals.
- **Wise counsel** from leaders, mentors, and family members helps refine and adjust your goals along the way.
