Welcome - The Lordship of Christ: Every Knee Will Bow

Kingdom leadership starts with absolute surrender to the Lordship of Jesus. As leaders, our lives, decisions, and actions must fully reflect Christ's authority over us.

A. Godly Leaders Need a Close Relationship with Jesus

- **Jesus is Lord**—this truth shapes everything in our lives.
- Every decision, action, and priority must be submitted to Him.
- Romans 8:29 – "For those whom He foreknew, He also predestined to become conformed to the image of His Son."
- God's ultimate purpose is to **make us like Jesus** and for us to **partner with Him** in His mission.

B. It Starts with Humility

- Jesus set the example of **humility and servanthood**:
 - Philippians 2:8 – "And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross."
 - Jesus washed the feet of His disciples—including **Judas, who would betray Him**.
- True leadership is **servant leadership**—not seeking power but modeling Christ's humility.

C. He Called His Disciples to Follow Him into Mission and Destiny

- Jesus **trained, taught, corrected, and modeled** Kingdom leadership.
- His disciples learned through **relationship and experience**.
- We are called to **respond to His love, accept His calling, and follow Him fully**.
- John 14:15 – "If you love me, you will keep my commandments."
- Worship is not just **singing songs**—it is surrendering our **entire lives** to Him.

3. Do you obey Jesus out of love, duty, or obligation? How does this impact your leadership?
