Welcome - Supernatural Guidance: Wisdom and Revelation

Kingdom leadership requires supernatural guidance. The Holy Spirit provides wisdom, revelation, and direction in many ways, helping us navigate leadership challenges.

A. Five Foundations of Supernatural Guidance

The Lord guides us through various means. Jesus is called the Word, and He communicates with His people. John 10:27 – "My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me."

1. The Voice of God

- God speaks into our **spirit** through prayer, the Word, and direct impressions.
- We must train ourselves to **listen and discern**.
- Keeping a **journal** of what we sense God speaking helps us track His guidance.
- Test what you hear—God will never contradict His Word. Submitting words to **leaders and trusted peers** ensures confirmation.

2. The Gifts of the Spirit

- The Holy Spirit speaks through **spiritual gifts** such as prophecy, words of knowledge, and words of wisdom.
- 1 Corinthians 14:3 – "The one who prophesies speaks to people for their strengthening, encouragement, and comfort."
- Prophecy is meant to **edify, exhort, and console**.
- Every prophetic word must be **tested** and **aligned with Scripture**.

3. Supernatural Circumstances

- God can lead through **events and situations**.
- Both **positive and negative** experiences can be used to shape and direct our path.
- Romans 8:28 – "And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love Him."

4. Godly Mentors and Community

- Leadership is not meant to be **isolated**.
- God provides **mentors, pastors, and spiritual leaders** to offer counsel and confirmation.
- Wise leaders surround themselves with **accountability and trusted voices**.

5. Scriptural Wisdom

- God's Word is the **primary and unchanging** source of guidance.
- Psalm 119:105 – "Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path."
- Regular study of **Scripture** helps align decisions with **God's will**.
