### Welcome - The Role of Mentors and Leaders

Kingdom leadership is not meant to be pursued alone. God provides mentors and leaders to guide, equip, and refine us as we grow into our calling.

### A. God Gives Supernatural Guidance Through Wise Counsel

- Throughout Scripture, God has guided His people through mentors and leaders:
  - **Moses mentored Joshua**
  - **Samuel mentored David**
  - **Jesus mentored the twelve**
  - **Paul mentored Timothy and Titus**
- Family is the model for relationships in both **heaven and earth**.
- Physical family provides for **natural multiplication**, and **spiritual family** provides for **spiritual multiplication**.

### B. Spiritual Multiplication

- God commanded Adam and Eve to multiply **physically**.
- Jesus commanded His followers to multiply **spiritually**:
  - Matthew 28:19-20 – "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, teaching them to follow all that I commanded you."
- Paul's **four-generation discipleship model** (2 Timothy 2:2):
  - "The things which you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses, entrust these to faithful people who will be able to teach others also."
- The **Great Commission is spiritual multiplication in action**—this is what we are called to do.

### C. Character and Integrity Matter in Leadership

- Leaders are **not perfect**, and many have encountered **flawed leadership**.
- Despite past wounds, **we must pursue Christ-like leadership**.
- Effective leaders:
  - **Process pain and disappointments without projecting them onto others.**
  - **Seek accountability and trusted mentors.**
  - **Humbly submit to God and others.**
  - **Allow mature believers to speak into their lives.**

## D. All Authority is Delegated Authority

- Leaders are **accountable to God**, and all **authority comes from Him**.
- The centurion in Matthew 8:8-10 recognized Jesus' authority because **he understood submission**:
  - "For I also am a man under authority, with soldiers under me... Say the word, and my servant will be healed."
  - Jesus **linked faith to recognizing authority**.
- Leaders must learn both to **lead and to follow**.

## E. Supernatural Alignment with Leadership

- Authority must be **respected in both directions**:
  - Leaders must **respect those they lead**.
  - Leaders must also **honor those who lead them**.
- If you have a **problem with authority**, those under you will likely develop the same issue.
- When **alignment is present**, a powerful **synergy** is created, allowing God to move freely in a leader's life.
