Welcome - Leadership is People Movement

Leadership is about **developing people and guiding them toward a purpose**. Every leader, regardless of their position, influences individuals. As Kingdom leaders, we are called to help others grow and accomplish their God-given destiny.

A. Leadership is Personally Moving People to Grow and Accomplish Things

- Leadership is **not just about authority** but about helping others succeed.
- Discipleship focuses on **developing people**, while leadership focuses on **moving people toward a goal**.
- Leaders are called to **support God's leadership process** in the lives of those they lead.

B. Pray for Those You Lead

- Seek **God's wisdom** in leading others (James 1:5).
- Pray for **understanding of their calling** and how you can help them.
- Make prayer a **consistent practice** in your leadership.

C. Positional Leadership vs. Relational Leadership

- **Positional Leadership:** Authority is given by a title or role.
- **Relational Leadership:** Authority is earned through **trust and care**.
- Effective leadership **combines both**—leaders should **develop relationships** while also operating within their **God-given authority**.
- **Example:** King David's men loved and respected him not just because of his title but because of his **relationship** with them.

D. The Simple Destiny Development Process

1. **Get to Know Those You Lead** – Who are they? Discover their **gifts, traits, and passions**.
2. **Help Them Discover Their Callings** – What is their purpose in the Kingdom? Guide them in identifying their **God-given mission**.
3. **Mentor and Support Them** – How can you help? Assist them in creating a **practical plan** and provide **counsel, support, and feedback**.
