### Welcome - The Mandate of Heaven: Where There is No Vision...

Leadership is about **moving people toward their God-given purpose**. Without vision, people lack direction and motivation. A clear vision fuels purpose, growth, and transformation.

#### A. Leading from Need vs. Leading from Vision

- Leaders can either **respond to needs** or **lead toward vision**.
- Vision is a **picture of the future**, a **goal or outcome** that provides motivation.
- "Vision is the fuel for motivation, and motivation is the engine for change."
- **Positive vision** creates lasting motivation, while **need-based leadership** only works if the need is personal or urgent.
- Biblical Pattern: Around **70% of biblical promises** are **reward-based**, 20% are **warning-based**, and 10% are **love-based**.
- **God leads primarily through vision and reward**, not just by addressing needs.

#### B. Understanding God's Vision for the People You Lead

- Biblical vision is **specific revelation** from God about His **intentions and plans**.
- Leaders must first **discern God's vision** for the people they lead.
- It is essential to **align leadership with God's plan** for each person's life.

#### C. God's Purpose for Each Person

- Ephesians 2:10 – "We are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them."
- God has **specific purposes** for individuals beyond general Christian duties.
- These unique **callings and destinies** define a person's personal vision for the Kingdom.
- Leaders help others **identify, engage, and map out a journey** toward fulfilling that vision.

#### D. Applying the Destiny Process

- Leaders should **guide others** through a discovery process of their calling.
- Destiny Finder Journey Guide is a helpful tool for **assessments, feedback, and strategic planning**.
- Leaders help create a **life map**—practical steps that develop character, ministry, and leadership skills.
- This approach can even **extend to those who don't yet know Christ**, beginning with their **personal relationship with the Lord**.

1. **Who are you? What are your strongest natural and spiritual gifts, passions, and personality traits?**

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2. **Where are you going? What is your specific, unique God-given calling or destiny?**

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3. **Dream Statement: If you had no limits of time, energy, money, or talent, and knew you couldn't fail, what would you love to do for God?**

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4. Expand your dream statement from above into one or two paragraphs.

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5. Condense your dream statement into ten words or less.

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**Activation:**

**Step 1: List the obstacles to your dream being fulfilled.**

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**Step 2: Identify one step you can take this week toward overcoming an obstacle.**
