### Welcome - Clarifying Vision: God's Blueprint - Get Specific

God has a **specific vision for each person**, and leadership involves **helping others clarify and pursue their God-given destiny**. Vision brings **direction, focus, and motivation**.

#### A. Understanding One's Vision: Your History

- The first step to leading someone is **understanding their God-given vision**.
- Ask: What has God shown you about your calling and purpose?
- Clues to vision are found in **personal history**:
  - What was your childhood like?
  - As a child, what did you want to be when you grew up?
  - How did you come to faith in Jesus?

#### B. Discovering Your Gifts

- Look at how **God uses you**.
- Explore the **spiritual gifts** in:
  - Ephesians 4
  - Romans 12
  - 1 Corinthians 12
- Identify the gifts that **best describe you**.
- Use the **Destiny Finder Journey Guide** for more detailed assessments.

#### C. Identify Your Passions

- Consider **how you are wired**:
  - What **sphere of society** do you feel called to impact? (Business, church, government, entertainment, family, etc.)
  - What **issues are you passionate about**?
  - What type of people do you feel **called to minister to**?
  - What type of organization do you thrive in?
- The **Destiny Finder Journey Guide** can help provide a deeper **personal inventory**.

#### D. Look at How God Has Been Working in Your Life

- What has **God spoken to you in prayer**?
- Have you received **prophetic words** about your calling?
- What have **leaders, friends, and family** said concerning your destiny?
- Which **Bible characters do you identify with**?

## E. Clarify Your Dream or Destiny

- Answer this **dream question**:

“If you had no limits of time, energy, money, or talent, and knew you couldn’t fail, what would you love to do for God?”

- Try to give a **specific answer**—this is your **dream (your destiny)**.

## F. Discern God's Specific Perspective on Each Person You Are Leading

- Help people **understand their destiny**.
- Show them how **personal growth, character development, and service** are all part of their journey.
- Assist them in **processing their dream** and developing a practical **life map** with specific steps.

## G. Seek Mentoring

- A **mentor is invaluable** in leadership development.
- **Mentorship vs. Coaching**:
  - **Coaching** helps individuals **discover answers** for themselves.
  - **Mentorship** is **experience-based**—the mentor **imparts wisdom and skill development**.
- A mentor **accelerates growth** by providing real-world guidance.

## H. Help the Person Understand the WHY

- Ask **why** certain experiences, dreams, or influences are meaningful.
- **Why did they enjoy a specific experience?**
- **Why did they aspire to be like a certain figure?**
- These insights provide **clues to their personal destiny**.
