Welcome - Community Development: Cultivating a Culture of Growth

Leadership is not just about individual growth but also about **multiplication and community development**. A thriving leadership culture ensures that values, principles, and skills are passed on to future generations.

A. Our Mandate as Believers is to Multiply Spiritually

- **Multiplication happens through personal development and relationships.**
- Every generation should **train and equip** the next, passing on values, practices, and beliefs.
- **Healthy leaders build healthy communities**, which continue to grow and impact others.

B. Everyone Needs to Be on a Developmental Path

- Spiritual maturity leads to **fulfilling God's Kingdom purpose**.

- Leaders must create **clear pathways for growth**, both personally and organizationally.

C. Community Health is Essential for the Individual and the Organization

A helpful model for measuring personal and community development is the **5 H's**:

1. Health:

- Physical health, emotional well-being, family relationships, and personal stability.

2. Head:

- Knowledge, doctrinal understanding, and continuous learning to grow in wisdom.

3. Heart:

- Character formation, spiritual maturity, and cultivating the **fruit of the Spirit**.

4. Hands:

- Practical skills for ministry, leadership, and service.

5. Holy Spirit:

- Deep relationship with God, sensitivity to the Spirit's leading, and walking in His presence.

D. Leaders Must Build Relationships and Processes that Develop Healthy People

- **Trust is the foundation of leadership.**
- Productivity is important, but leadership must also **focus on relationships.**
- When leaders genuinely invest in people, trust grows, allowing for **greater influence and impact.**
- A leadership culture built on **love, integrity, and mentorship** creates a community that is strong, healthy, and influential.
