Session Five: Strategic Leadership and Synergy

Overview

This session introduces strategic leadership and explains how leaders maximize limited resources to achieve the greatest Kingdom impact.

1. Strategic Leadership

Strategy is the maximized use of limited resources for the highest possible impact.

Leaders must steward time, people, finances, and opportunities effectively.

2. Fruitfulness and Focus

God calls leaders to be fruitful.

Fruitfulness requires focus, intentional planning, and alignment with God's purposes.

3. Understanding Human Resources

Every team member has unique gifts and abilities.

Leaders must recognize these strengths and place individuals in roles where they can flourish.

4. The House Building Analogy

A master builder coordinates multiple specialists when constructing a house.

Each worker contributes a specific skill to the overall project.

5. Five-Fold Leadership Gifts

Ephesians 4 identifies apostle, prophet, evangelist, pastor, and teacher.

Each reflects a different dimension of Christ's leadership.

6. Strategic Alignment

Leaders must understand both the strengths and limitations of team members.

Responsibilities should be assigned strategically.

7. Sequencing and Process

Successful organizations develop in stages.

Leaders must implement projects in the correct order to avoid inefficiency.

8. Synergy and Momentum

When teams align effectively, synergy occurs.

Synergy means the whole becomes greater than the sum of the parts.
