

## Advanced Kingdom Leadership Course

### Module 3

#### Session Six: Spirit-Led Leadership

##### Overview

This session focuses on Spirit-led leadership. True Kingdom leadership begins when leaders align themselves with Christ's leadership.

##### 1. Self Leadership

Leaders must learn to lead themselves through discipline, faithfulness, and responsibility.

##### 2. Being Led by the Spirit

Romans 8 teaches that the sons of God are led by the Spirit of God.

Spiritual leadership begins with surrendering control to Christ.

##### 3. Christ at the Center

Many people place themselves at the center of their lives.

Kingdom leadership places Christ at the center instead.

##### 4. From Servants to Friends

Jesus described a shift from servant to friend.

Friends understand the heart of the master and participate in His mission.

##### 5. Wisdom and Revelation

Wisdom comes from the Word of God.

Revelation comes from the ongoing work of the Holy Spirit.

## 6. Scripture as Foundation

The Bible is the primary authority for faith and practice.

Revelation never contradicts Scripture.

## 7. Sonship and Identity

Believers are sons and daughters of God.

This identity gives intimacy and access to God's heart.

## 8. Leadership Alignment

Spirit-led leaders align their decisions with God's purposes.

This alignment produces true influence and lasting impact.
