

## Advanced Kingdom Leadership Course

### Module 4

#### Session Four: The Gifts of the Spirit in Kingdom Leadership

##### Overview

This session introduces the spiritual gifts described in 1 Corinthians 12 and explains their role in supernatural Kingdom leadership. These gifts empower believers to bring God's wisdom, healing, and power into real-life situations.

##### 1. Leadership Empowered by the Holy Spirit

Jesus began His ministry after being filled with the Holy Spirit.

Kingdom leadership depends on the presence and power of the Spirit rather than human ability alone.

##### 2. The Purpose of Spiritual Gifts

The gifts of the Spirit are given to build up the body of Christ and demonstrate God's power.

Leaders should desire spiritual gifts while maintaining humility and love.

##### 3. Word of Wisdom

The word of wisdom provides supernatural insight for solving problems.

It allows leaders to respond to complex situations with divine understanding.

##### 4. Word of Knowledge

A word of knowledge provides information that could not be known naturally.

God may reveal hidden details about situations or people to bring healing or direction.

##### 5. Discerning of Spirits

This gift allows leaders to recognize whether a spiritual influence is from God, human motivation, or demonic influence.

It helps leaders respond wisely in spiritually sensitive situations.

## 6. Gifts of Miracles and Healing

God empowers believers to demonstrate His power through miracles and healing.

These gifts reveal God's compassion and authority in the world.

## 7. Tongues and Interpretation

These gifts help believers communicate spiritual truths through supernatural means.

They can strengthen personal prayer life and build up the church when interpreted.

## 8. Growing in Spiritual Gifts

Spiritual gifts grow through practice, humility, and obedience to the Holy Spirit.

Leaders should step out in faith and allow God to refine their spiritual sensitivity.
