Session Six: Servant Leadership

Overview

This session introduces servant leadership as a core principle of biblical leadership. It emphasizes that true leadership is expressed through service, humility, and the desire to help others grow.

1. Levels of Leadership Development

Level 1: Leading yourself.

Level 2: Living under the guidance of the Holy Spirit.

Level 3: Leading your world—how you influence the environments around you.

Level 4: Servant leadership—leading others through humility and service.

2. The Foundation of Servant Leadership

Jesus taught that leaders should not dominate others but serve them.

True leadership is demonstrated through influence, sacrifice, and humility.

3. The Example of Jesus

In John 13, Jesus washed the feet of His disciples as a demonstration of servant leadership.

He served even Judas, knowing Judas would betray Him.

4. Leadership Through Service

Leadership is not about status, authority, or recognition.

It is about serving people and helping them grow into their full potential.

5. The Role of Character

Servant leadership begins with personal character and humility before God.

A secure identity in God's love allows leaders to serve others without striving for validation.

6. Servant Leadership in Everyday Life

Servant leadership applies in families, churches, businesses, and communities.

Leaders build healthy cultures by consistently serving and supporting others.

7. Developing Others

Servant leaders see themselves as developers of people.

They help others discover their gifts, purpose, and calling.

3. What practical steps can you take to model servant leadership in your daily life?
